What's on this month and beyond. We're currently open and the arena is ready to host birthday parties and events.

AND WE'VE GOT BUMPER CARS... ON ICE!

The Queenstown Ice Arena is excited to introduce Ice Bumpers Cars as a brand new activity in Queenstown. These

are not your typical bumper cars – ours travel on the ice! Bump, slide and spin into your friends and family in these battery operated cars that are the first attraction of their kind in the southern hemisphere.

Easily controlled by two gamer style joysticks, which control two independent motors these cars are a ton of fun for all ages and abilities. All drivers must be a minimum of 1200mm in height; and age 6 years or older. Those aged 3-5 years may ride with parent or guardian over 18 years of age.

Ice Bumper Car sessions involve 8 cars per session and each ride lasts ten minutes. Rides run every 30 minutes on a designated area covering 1/3 of the rink. Public Skating continues on the other 2/3 of the ice surface. Due to limited availability, advance online bookings are ESSENTIAL. KIDS LEARN TO PLAY ICE HOCKEY

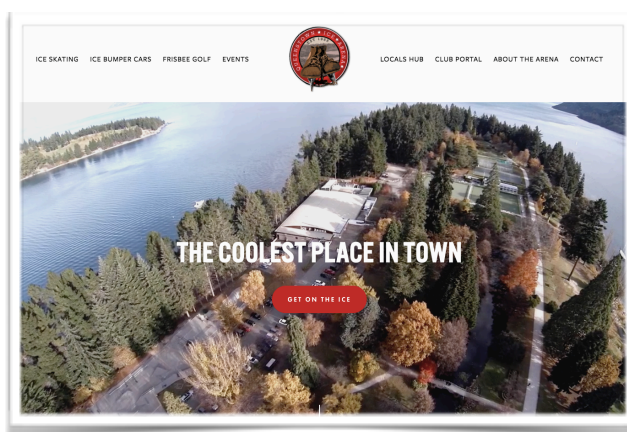

And In Case You're Curious...We're all about Virus Prevention.

While we've kicked Covid-19 out of the country, we will be instituting some of our own changes to help keep you safer when you visit .

Ice Arena Procedures:

- For your own records, you may check in using the government QR code for the Queenstown Ice Arena. This will be displayed at the entrance lobby for your convenience.
- We will be instituting a more rigorous cleaning schedule taking extra care to sanitise and wipe down frequently touched items such as: door handles, skates, taps, bench tops and helmets.
- Anyone using a rink issued helmet must collect and return the helmet to the skate counter to be cleaned. Skaters must wear a hair net if using a rink helmet.
- Please use sensible hygiene practices like coughing into your elbow, regularly washing your hands and staying home if feeling unwell.

Business As Usual

Along with public skating, lessons, family fun, party hire and group activities, the arena has a fully licensed café offering a selection of local wines, as well as craft beers on tap. And don't forget there are frisbees for hire at the arena so the whole family or a group of friends can enjoy a game of disc golf in the Gardens.
